## Ranch Roping Checklist

- Get director approval of your roping date(s). Contact a director for membership cards.
- Print copies of waivers, current rules, score sheets, and a payout schedule. You will need a score sheet for each team (open and novice), and you will need to have rule sheets posted at your roping.
- Ropers must be prepared to show a current membership card or proof of purchase.
- You will need numbers for the cattle.
- You need to have at least **2** judges available.
- You need to have at least **2** people lined up to time, score keep, and announce.
- Chalk or lime to establish rodear line.

After the roping you will need to send in:

1. Membership purchase information and money.
2. All score sheets.
3. A complete breakdown of your final payout.

NOTE: The novice should run after the open, so the cattle are not fresh.
